

GREEN TEA

PINHEAD GUNPOWDER GREEN

From the Chinese region of Zhejiang, the leaves for this tea are plucked when the quality of green tea is at its highest, steamed and tightly rolled into tiny pellets in a time honoured fashion.
An oaky green tea, with a hint of grassiness and memorable aroma.

SENCHA FUKUJYU

One of Japan's most popular natural leaf green teas, its large flat leaves produce a refreshing silky, sweet and grassy taste with light notes of hay. A lively, sparkling character, high in vitamin C, which can be drunk with meals or as a digestive.

DRAGON PEARL JASMINE (+ £2.00)

Beautiful hand rolled pearls of green tea infused with jasmine flowers providing a highly perfumed and perfectly balanced tea.
This is a masterpiece from Fuan, China which is full of floral and sweet aromas.

FINE TEA

SILVER NEEDLES YIN ZHEN(+ £3.00)

One of the rarest most glamorous teas. A China white tea, made from tender new buds beautifully silver coloured from the Fujian Province. Picked only two days a year, producing a sweet and delicate cup with clean peachy taste hints of melon.
Highly prized and tantalizing.

HU SHAN YELLOW BUDS – GOLDEN TEA(+ £3.00)

An exclusive yellow tea from the ancient Anhui province, used as an imperial tribute during the Ming and Qing dynasty.
An amazing tea which is fresh, silky and mellow with an almost savory corn sweetness.

THE COWORTH PARK AFTERNOON BLEND

DARJEELING

The champagne and Queen of teas, high in the mountains in the mists surrounding the Himalayas this tea is grown. Our Darjeeling is a blend of first flush and Autumnal teas from the best gardens ensuring it is light, bright and fragrant.

CEYLON ORANGE PEKOE

A delightful high-grown tea from Uva. Its leaves produce an intense tea that is bright, brisk and clean. It is guaranteed to pick you up on dull afternoons.

WUYISAN LAPSANG SOUCHONG

An ancient and much loved Chinese black tea from the original Lapsang producers. This black tea has the delicate smokiness but is very elegant.
